

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF A RAIL CROSSING DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND
STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 119A
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT – SECTION 53A(2)**

HEATH CHARNOCK FOOTPATH 44 (PART), CHORLEY BOROUGH
RAIL CROSSING DIVERSION ORDER 2017**

On the 16th August 2017, Lancashire County Council confirmed the above Order made under section 119A of the Highways Act 1980.

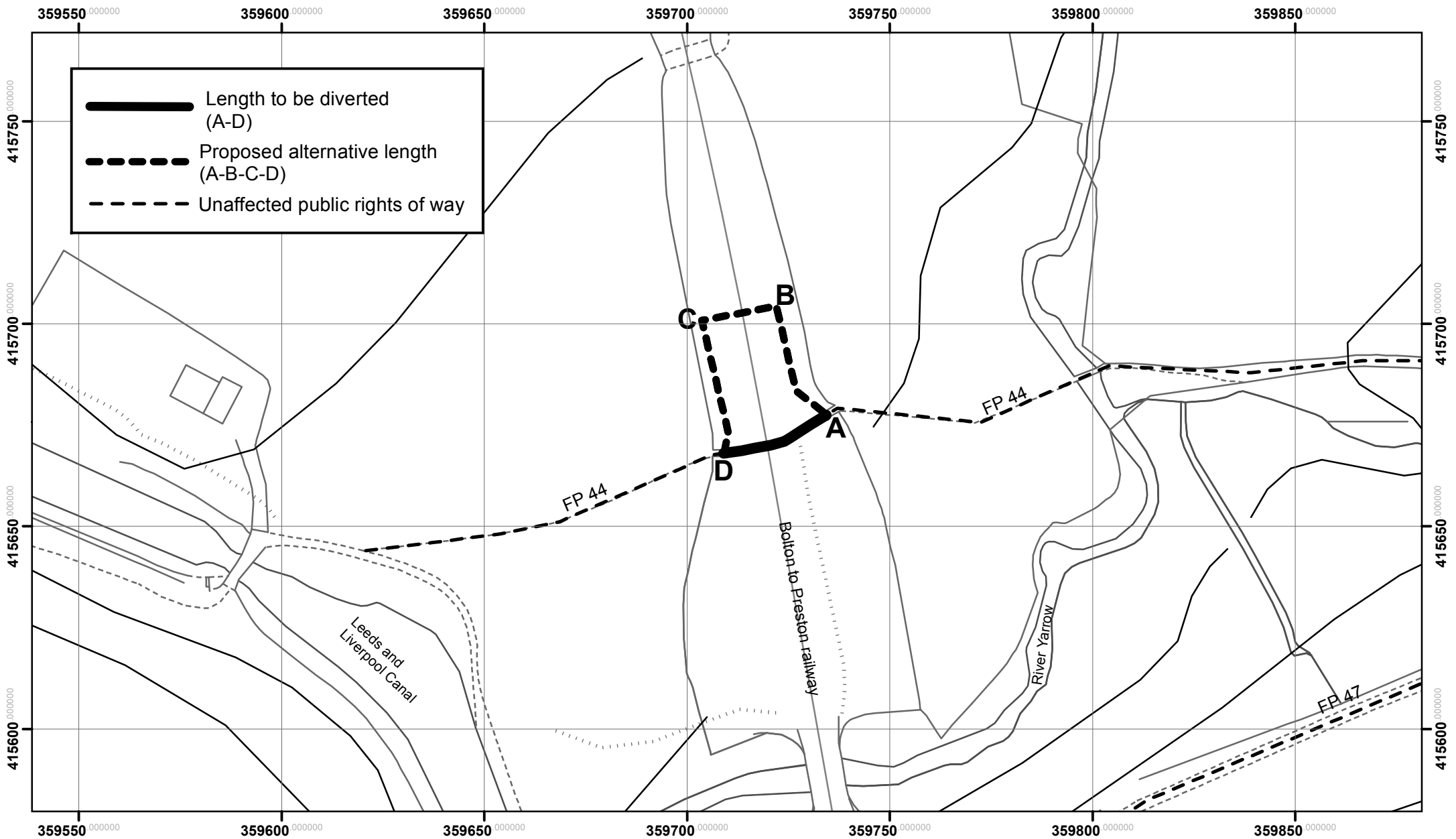
The effect of the Order, as confirmed is to divert that part of Heath Charnock Footpath 44 at the Heath Charnock Level Crossing on the Bolton to Preston railway, running grid reference SD 5973 1567 generally west south west for 30 metres to SD 5970 1566, to a new line running between the same points but over a stepped footbridge as shown on the Order Map.

A copy of the Order as confirmed and the Order Map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the offices of Chorley Borough Council and at my offices from 9am to 5pm on weekdays. Copies of the Order and Map may be bought there at the price of £1.00.

The creation of the new footpath came into force on 30th August 2017 and the extinguishment of the original public right of way came into force on 8th November 2018, when the highway authority for the new footpath certified that the work to bring it into a fit condition for public use has been carried out, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that a requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from the 27th November 2018, make an application to the High Court.
